Community-wide Spring Shred Day Offered at Lakeshore Park

KNOXVILLE, TENN [March 2018] – The 2018 community-wide Spring Shred Day will take place this Saturday, March 24 at Lakeshore Park in Knoxville, TN. Shred trucks will be on site from 9:00am – 12:00pm or until trucks reach full capacity. This free event is open to the entire community, regardless of membership with the Credit Union, with shredding offered on a first come, first serve basis.

“Whether we’re helping people grow financially or simply helping with a little spring cleaning, we love being able to meet the people of the communities we serve,” said Shred Day Volunteer Coordinator, Mary Beth McCauley.

Shred Day traffic should enter Lakeshore Park off Northshore Drive and follow signs to the shred location. Each vehicle is allowed four banker’s boxes or four tall kitchen trash bags of acceptable shred items. Items that are not accepted for shredding include: cardboard, 3 ring binders, phone books, hard copy books, common or wet trash, plastics or metals, and hazardous materials such as batteries, cell phones and CDs.
